SIGNIFICANT VERDICTS & SETTLEMENTS

\$24,529,286.00 Medical Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for claims against an orthopedic physician, the physician’s group and a hospital for the actions of its nurses that led to the amputation of a 14-year-old young man’s right leg. *Reginald B. Harris, Jr., a Minor, et al. vs. Sumter Regional Hospital, Inc., Albany Orthopaedic Clinic, Inc., Duncan R. Marsh, C.A.F. 06CV2533-1 Superior Court of Dougherty County, Albany, Georgia (2008).*

\$16,500,000.00 Medical Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for minor child who suffered liver failure and a liver transplant at 4 months of age caused by a failure of her health care providers to follow-up on an abnormal cyst detected on ultrasound in utero. *Yamada vs. Northside Hospital, Inc., Northside Pediatrics & Adolescent Medicine, P.C. and Women’s Health Associates, P.C., C.A.F. 2005VS076354G State Court of Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia (2006).* August 2006.

\$12,000,000.00 Medical Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for a severely brain injured child who suffers from hypoxic ischemic encephalopathy, including cerebral palsy, seizure disorders, and global developmental delays as a result of an untimely cesarean section and mismanagement of labor by a nurse midwife and an obstetrician. *Tate v. Clark-Holder Clinic et al., C.A.F. SU01CV2528 Muscogee County Superior Court, Columbus, Georgia (2001).* September 2002.

\$6,250,000.00 Medical Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for a 32 year old male against a hospital and a subsidiary company owned by the hospital for injuries suffered as a result of an improperly performed colostomy. The verdict included \$1,000,000.00 for loss of consortium to his spouse. *Krenson Edward Kniphfer, et al. v. Memorial Health University Medical Center, Inc. and MPPG, Inc., C.A.F. 1010574F Chatham County State Court, Savannah, Georgia (2001).* November 2001.

\$5,250,000.00 Wrongful Death – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for the wrongful death of three children who burned in a propane explosion due to the

negligence of an agent for Blossman Gas, Inc. in illegally filling an out-of-date 100 pound propane tank with a defective valve. *Ginger Evans v. Blossman Gas, Inc., Blossman Gas, Inc. of Georgia, and H&H Shoppette, Inc., C.A.F. 03-VS-050554 Fulton County State Court, Atlanta, Georgia (2004)*. October 2004.

\$1,265,000.00 Medical Negligence – jury verdict in a cosmetic surgery case representing compensatory damages for a 71 year old lady who suffered scars on her face following simultaneous full face CO2 laser resurfacing and facelift. This verdict included \$250,000.00 for loss of consortium to her spouse. *Betty Nestlehutt et al. v. Atlanta Oculoplastic Surgery, P.C. d/b/a Oculus, C.A.F. 2007-CV-002223J Fulton County State Superior Court, Atlanta, Georgia (2008)*. September 2008.

\$1,015,538.20 Trucking Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages equaling the full value of the life of 43 year old male who was killed in a collision with a tractor-trailer carrying a load of logs. *Leslie Phillips, et al. v. Meeks Logging Co., Inc., C.A.F. 01-CV-211 Emanuel County Superior Court (2001)*. July 2002.

\$760,000.00 Negligent Supervision of a Child – jury verdict and collected **\$913,021.98** after verdict affirmed on appeal. Amount represents compensatory damages for nine-year-old child who suffered two broken legs and keloid scarring after being struck by a truck as a result of the Ledic after school program supervisor's failure to provide adequate child supervision. *Shaatia J'nai Brown, et al. v. Ledic Management Group et. al., C.A.F. 99VS0154307H Fulton County State Court, Atlanta, Georgia (1999)*. July 2000.

\$126,000.00 Negligence – jury verdict representing compensatory damages for a 42 year-old male who was mishandled by Delta agents when they carelessly dislodged a surgical drain tube in his hip while rendering him assistance exiting the aircraft. *Carraro v. Delta Airlines Inc. and AHL Services, Inc., C.A.F. 00VS0023206, Fulton County State Court, Atlanta, Georgia (2000)*. January 2001.

\$3,500,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement against a hospital employed orthopedic surgeon for failure to timely diagnose and consult a vascular surgeon for an injury to the popliteal artery resulting from a traumatic knee dislocation and resulting in an above-knee amputation and total disability for a 32 year-old female dairy farmer. (April, 2015)

\$2,250,000.00 Medical Negligence/Wrongful Death – confidential pre-suit settlement against a teaching hospital for the wrongful death of a 59 year-old female and grandmother of two who bled to death in the operating room from a trocar injury caused by the resident surgeons while performing a laparoscopic repair of a hiatal hernia. (February, 2015)

\$1,350,000.00 Wrongful Death/Auto Collision – confidential policy limits settlement for the parents of a 15 year-old boy who was killed while riding in the back seat of his grandparent's automobile when a speeding jeep on GA Hwy 400 crashed into the side of his vehicle. (September, 2015)

\$1,500,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement of claims against a vascular surgeon for failure to timely and properly repair an intraoperative injury to the popliteal artery immediately following a total knee replacement resulting in an above-knee amputation and permanent disability for a 65 year-old school bus driver. (April, 2015)

\$4,000,000.00 Trucking Negligence – confidential settlement of claims against a company whose tractor trailer driver failed to slow for traffic and rear ended the plaintiff's vehicle causing multiple broken bones and an aortic dissection requiring surgical repair. (December, 2014)

\$1,300,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement arising out of the negligent administration and failure to appropriately treat complications of spinal anesthesia during a c-section resulting in maternal brain damage. (September, 2014)

\$4,500,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement for failure to timely diagnose spinal cord compression from an acute cervical disc herniation resulting in quadriplegia and ultimately the wrongful death of the patient. (January, 2014)

\$5,000,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement for hypoxic ischemic brain injury to child during labor and delivery which could have been prevented by expediting delivery with a c-section. (January, 2014)

\$5,900,000.00 Trucking Negligence – confidential settlement for incomplete spinal cord injuries to the plaintiff who was sleeping in the sleeper berth when the driver of the tractor-trailer fell asleep at the wheel, left the roadway, and caused the tractor-trailer to roll over. (January, 2014)

\$6,000,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement arising out of the failure to diagnose a traumatic knee dislocation resulting in a below knee amputation against a hospital and orthopedic surgeon. (September, 2013)

\$1,950,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement of claims against an ENT office for negligently injecting acid instead of antibiotic solution into an infant's ears before placement of tubes for a chronic ear infection and causing permanent loss of hearing. (September, 2013)

\$1,000,000.00 Wrongful Death – settlement for the statutorily maximum recoverable amount against the Georgia Department of Transportation for negligently permitting excessive pooling and flow of rainwater through the roadway creating a deadly hydroplaning hazard for motorists and resulting in the wrongful death of 41 year old David Morris. *Teresa Ann Morris, Individually as Surviving Spouse of David Thomas Morris, Deceased; and as Administratrix of the Estate of David Thomas Morris, Plaintiff v. The Georgia Department of Transportation and Nicholas Alonzo Lovero, Defendants, C.A.F. 2011CV201DB, Lumpkin County State Court, Dahlonega, Georgia.* September, 2012.

\$4,000,000.00 Trucking Negligence – settlement for the wrongful death of 59 year-old Rosa Tillman who was a back seat passenger in a vehicle rear ended by the driver of a large box truck. (August, 2012)

\$1,800,000.00 Premises Liability – confidential settlement against a large corporation for negligently failing to place proper guards or screens around the skylights in the roof of its building and caused the death of a contractor who fell through one of the unguarded skylights. (March, 2012)

\$1,100,000.00 Traumatic Brain Injury – confidential settlement of claims for traumatic brain injury caused by defendant truck driver who negligently rear ended the plaintiff while stopped on a motorcycle behind a school bus. (January, 2012)

\$775,000.00 Mild Traumatic Brain Injury – confidential settlement of claims for negligent threading of a component on a dual dry ice block press which separated under pressure and hit the plaintiff in the head. (August, 2012)

\$750,000.00 Trucking Negligence – confidential settlement by trucking company who negligently attempted a u-turn while towing a flatbed trailer at night without adequate reflective tape resulting in a collision and a torn rotator cuff. (June, 2011)

\$850,000.00 Negligence – confidential settlement of claims for blindness in one eye caused by defendant who negligently attempted to tow a tractor stuck in gravel with a pick-up truck by connecting a chain to the bumper of the tractor and the ball hitch on the bumper of the pick-up truck and then snatched the ball out of the bumper causing it to be projected into the plaintiff's eye socket. (June, 2011)

\$1,250,000.00 Trucking Negligence – confidential settlement of claims for fractures to the pelvis and both legs arising out of a tractor trailer collision caused by a stalled tractor trailer on the highway. (May, 2011)

\$1,000,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement representing full policy limits for a brachial plexus injury to a child during birth. (April, 2011)

\$1,150,000.00 Aviation Negligence – confidential settlement of wrongful death claims arising out of an airplane crash against the company in charge of controlling and clearing traffic for landing at a metro area airfield and who negligently cleared this flight for landing when the conditions on the field were below IFR minimums. \$800,000.00 Motor Vehicle Negligence – settlement for orthopedic and soft tissue injuries suffered by 72 year-old Joseph Fain when an employee of Blue Ridge Auto Auctions lost control of a vehicle inside the auction building and hit Mr. Fain. (December, 2010)

\$2,850,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential settlement of a surgical error which occurred during abdominal surgery for a hiatal hernia repair where the surgeon destroyed

the blood supply to the patient's stomach resulting in a total gastrectomy. (December, 2010)

\$1,000,000.00 Dental Negligence – confidential settlement representing full policy limits of insurance in an action against a periodontist for the negligent placement of dental implants causing severe bone infection and resulting the amputation of the 72 year-old patient's jaw. (June, 2010)

\$5,900,000.00 Trucking Negligence/Traumatic Brain Injury – confidential presuit settlement arising out of an automobile collision on Interstate 75 in Atlanta, Georgia and resulting in the traumatic brain injury of a 32 year-old husband and father. (December, 2009)

\$4,992,050.10 Trucking Negligence/Traumatic Brain Injury – settlement representing full policy limits of insurance arising out of a tractor trailer collision at the I-575 northbound ramp and Hwy 92 in Cherokee County, Georgia and resulting in the traumatic brain injury of a 49 year-old husband and father. (January, 2010)

\$4,000,000.00 Trucking Negligence – confidential pretrial settlement representing the full insurance policy limits for the wrongful death of 48 year old man killed by a tractor-trailer truck driver who fell asleep at the wheel. (January, 2008)

\$12,350,000.00 Traumatic Brain Injury/Product Liability – confidential pretrial settlement arising out of a defective wheel which separated from a trailer on the interstate and crashed into the driver's side windshield of the 49 year-old plaintiff's vehicle hitting him in the head causing a traumatic brain injury leaving him with moderate cognitive deficits. (June, 2008)

\$1,300,000.00 Trucking Negligence – pretrial settlement for 43 year-old school teacher disabled from chronic low back pain following an automobile collision. *Blankenship v. Glover Food Service, et al.*, C.A.F. 04-SV-235 Sumter County State Court, Americus, Georgia. September, 2007.

\$8,000,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential pretrial settlement representing compensatory damages for complications caused by a botched elective surgical procedure for weight loss. (2007)

\$845,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential pre-suit settlement for 12 year old girl who suffered an incomplete neurologic problem causing numbness in one leg due to failure of tech to properly monitor evoked potentials during spine surgery. (2007)

\$1,200,000.00 Medical Negligence – confidential pretrial settlement representing compensatory damages for misdiagnosis of a spinal problem resulting in permanent paralysis. (2007)

\$700,000.00 Trucking Negligence – pretrial settlement representing compensatory damages for a 59 year old retired Vietnam veteran who suffered a fractured hip and pelvis when a tow truck failed to yield while turning left in front of him. *Horne v. Lewis & Lewis Towing, C.A.F. 06EV000367Y Fulton County State Court, Atlanta, Georgia (2006)*. (February, 2007)
